MANONMANIAM SUNDARANAR UNIVERSITY - REVISED SYLLABUS CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

Our Manonmaniam Sundaranar University has introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), a new pattern of curriculum, for the UG students from the academic year, 2008-2009 as per the instructions of the Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education (TANSCHE). In the revised CBCS syllabus, students have a good deal of freedom in designing their own curriculum to suit their needs and they can take any course ordered in any department as long as they fulfill the prerequisities for that course.

Every student has to study 4 types of courses

- 1. **CORE COURSES:** A set of courses (Like Major subjects) that a student must complete to get the degree.
- 2. **ALLIED COURSES:** A set of course (Like Ancillary subjects) in which limited choice is given.
- 3. **ELECTIVE COURSES:** A set of skill based elective courses left completely to the choice of the students to enable them employable. External and internal ratio is 60:40.
- 4. **NON-MAJOR ELECTIVE COURSES :** A set of Non-Major electives are left completely to the choice of the students. The subjects other than the major & allied shall be opted by the students as Non Major Elective.
- 5. **PART V EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:** There are extension activities like NCC, NSS, YOGA, SPORTS and YRC in our College. It is a must for each students to take part at least in any one of these activities for the fulfilment of the degree by securing a minimum of 35 marks out of 100 marks.
- 6. **PROJECT (PG Only)**: External: Internal = 80:20 Project report evalution & Viva-Voice will be conducted by both external examiner and guide.

The fee should be paid in Exam portal of the University, through online.

d. INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE STUDENTS DURING THE EXAMS:

The students should bring their **hall ticket** and **ID card** when they appear for all the university examinations.

Taking the **cellphone** and **hand written** or **printed paper bits** into the exam hall will be considered as a punishable offence. Before answering the questions, the students **should verify the subject code and the year in the question paper** given to them.

Students should maintain **silence** till the exams are over and they **should come out of the exam hall only after submitting their answer sheets to the hall superintendent** and getting his permission to leave.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- 1. It shall be the duty of every student to attend the College regularly and punctually on all the working days.
- 2. Attendance will be marked at the beginning of each class hour. While answering the attendance, the student shall stand up in his place.
- 3. A student who absents himself from the class during any one period of the day will be treated as absent for the session ($\frac{1}{2}$ a day)
- 4. Number of working days prescribed for each semester is 90. The following rules will apply for all semesters.
 - a. Those students who have earned in each subject 75% of attendance and above will be permitted to appear for university examination without any precondition. This includes attendance for practical classes also.
 - b. Those students who have earned from 60% to 74% of attendance must pay Condonation fee precribed by the University Such students should pay the prescribed condonation fee through online to the University before appearing for the University Exam.
 - c. Those students who have earned below 60% of attendance will not be permitted to appear for university Exam. They have TO REPEAT THE SEMESTER next semester, with prior permission from the College and University.

CERTIFICATE

Application for the issue of Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate, Course Certificate ect, must be made in the prescribed form and should be submitted to the Principal's office. An NOC to the effect that all arrears of fees to College have been cleared, must also accompany the application. 2. A late fee of RS.5/- will be charged if the student applies for Transfer Certificate ten days after the reopening of the College following the academic year during which he/ she was last enrolled. 3. Any student who leaves the College before completing the course without the written leave permission of the Principal will not be issued the conduct certificate.

SCHOLARSHIPS

1.Adi - Dravidar Welfare Scholarship:

Adi Dravidar Welfare Department Scholarships are granted under the Government of India and State Government Schemes. SC/St Hindu & Converted Christian students whose parents annual income is below Rs. 2,50,000/- are eligible for Free Education Scheme. They are eligible only for special fee concession.

ii.Backward Class Department:

- (A) Residential and Non-Residential Scholarships are sanctioned by the Backward Class Department to the students belonging to backward class if their parents annual income does not exceed Rs.2,50,000/- Backward Class U.G.students whose parents annual income is below Rs.2,50,000/- are eligible for First Generation Scheme.
- B). Most Backard & Denotified Community students whose parents annual income is below Rs.50,000/- are eligible for residential scholarship. The MBC & DNC U.G. students whose parents annual income is below Rs.2,50,000/- are eligible for Non-Residential Scholaship.

iii.National Merit Scholarhip:

This scholarship is granted on merit basis only. Prescribed forms and entitlement cards are sent to the students directly through the school in which they had studied last.

iv. National Loan Scholarship:

National Loan Scholarship is awarded to the students based on merit cum economical status. Students who have obtained 75% marks and whose parents annual income does not exceed Rs. 2,00,000/- are eligible.

v. Freedom Fighters Scholarship:

The children, grand children and adopted children of freedom fighters are awarded scholarship on production of certificate from the Tamilnadu Congress Committee containing particulars of imprisonment place and period.

vi. Defence Service Personal Scholarship:

Student whose father is working in military service is eligible for this scholarship. He should have obtained 50% of marks in the last annual examination. He is also eligible for military concession and exemption from payment of all items of special fees. Similarly if the brother of a student is in military service he is also eligible for military concession. Necessary certificate should be got signed by the commanding officer.

vii. Physically Handicapped Scholarship:

(a) Physically handicapped students / Orthopaedically handicapped (b) the blind and (c) the deaf under the age group of 16 to 30. They should have secured not less than 40% aggregate in the qualifying examination. They should not have received any other scholarships. For the application forms, the students should apply directly to the Director of Social Welfare, Thoothukudi District, Thoothukudi.

viii. M.S. University Merit Scholarship:

This scholarship is granted only on merit basis by the M.S. University

ix. Beedi worker's Children Scholarship:

This scholarship is granted to the children of Beedi workers only, through the District Social Welfare Officer.

x. Students Aid Fund:

Monetary help is given to the poor and meritorious students who are not getting any other scholarships. It is given on the basis of merit, annual income and also in accordance with the rules of the committee.

- Note :-1. Scholarship and fee Concession holders should earn 75% of attendance failing which the award will be withdrawn.
- 2. All the payments of Govt. Scholarships are credited through ECS only, and hence the students should open a SB Account in Tamilnad Mercantile Bank Ltd. in our College premises.

xi. Puthumai Penn:

Girl student who studied in Government school from 6th standard to 12th standard are eligible to receive Rs. 1000/- per month.
